



**Decision No. 1843
of 14 October 2020**

refusal of the derogation from the harmonisation of the 15 minutes imbalance settlement interval in accordance with Article 62 of Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/2195 of 23 November 2017 establishing a guideline on electricity balancing and Article 8 (4) of Regulation (EU) 2019/943 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 June 2019 on the internal market for electricity (recast)

Having regard to the provisions of art. 53 para. (1), of art. 62 para. (2) d) and para. (3) - (5), (8) and (10) of Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/2195 of 23 November 2017 establishing a guideline on electricity balancing, of art. 8 para. (4) of Regulation (EU) 2019/943 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 June 2019 on the internal market for electricity and of art. 36 para. (7) (r) of the Romanian electricity and natural gas Law no. 123/2012, as subsequently amended and supplemented, Having regard to the request of the National Electricity Transmission Company "Transelectrica" S.A., registered at the National Energy Regulatory Authority under no. 50371 / 26.06.2020, with subsequent completions,

Pursuant to the provisions of art. 62 para. (1), (6) and (9) of Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/2195 of 23 November 2017 establishing a guideline on electricity balancing and the provisions of art. 5 para. (1) (c) and (d) and of art. 9 para. (1) (h) of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 33/2007 on the organization and functioning of the National Energy Regulatory Authority, approved with amendments and completions by Law no. 160/2012, as subsequently amended and supplemented,

the President of the National Energy Regulatory Authority has adopted this

DECISION

Art. 1. (1) – The derogation from the harmonisation of the 15 minutes imbalance settlement interval in accordance with Article 62 of Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/2195 of 23 November 2017 establishing a guideline on electricity balancing and Article 8 (4) of Regulation (EU) 2019/943 of 5 June 2019 on the internal market for electricity (recast), requested by the National Electricity Transmission Company "Transelectrica" S.A. is refused.

(2) – The provisions of art. 8 para. (4) of Regulation (EU) 2019/0943 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 June 2019 on the internal market for electricity (recast), of art. 53 para. (1) of [Type here]

Commission Regulation (EU) 2017/2195 of 23 November 2017 establishing a guideline on electricity balancing and of the ANRE's Decree no. 63 of 31 March 2020 are mandatory.

Art. 3 – The National Electricity Transmission Company „Transelectrica” S.A. shall carry out the provisions of this Decision.

Art. 4 – ANRE's specific departments shall ensure compliance with the provisions of this Decision.

Art. 5 – (1) This Decision is communicated to the National Electricity Transmission Company "Transelectrica" S.A. and enters into force on the date of communication.

(2) This Decision shall be notified to the European Commission and to the Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators and shall be published on the website of the National Energy Regulatory Authority.
