



**INFORMATION REGARDING THE PROGRESS OF THE EUROPEAN
CONCERTED ACTION ON THE RENEWABLE ENERGY DIRECTIVE (CA-RES4)
PROJECT, IN WHICH ANRE IS PARTICIPATING AS A CONTRACTUAL
PARTNER DURING THE PERIOD 2021 – 2026**

The National Energy Regulatory Authority (ANRE) participates as a contractual partner beneficiary of funding, starting from June 2021 in a consortium of 28 European partner states, within the CA-RES4 Project - Concerted action to support transposition and implementation Directive 2018/2001/EC on the promotion of renewable energy sources, in accordance with Grant Agreement 101035887- CA-RES4 - Consortium Agreement.

The CA-RES4 project is an instrument of the Horizon 2020 program whose main objective is to support the transposition and implementation of the Directive on the promotion of the use of energy from renewable sources by creating and strengthening a network of experts to share their accumulated knowledge and experience, common approaches and a stronger coordination between participating countries. Thus, the European Commission provides technical assistance to the member states for the transposition and implementation of the Directive for the promotion of renewable energy sources through the European Project CA-RES4. Through a concerted action, the participating countries exchange experience and good practices, taking part in a process of cross-learning for the development of common approaches.

The parallel working sessions within the plenary meetings are organized according to the structure of 6 thematic groups (Core Theme CT1-CT6 2) of the CA-RES4 Project, namely:

CT1: Governance, target achievement and cooperation

CT2: RES Electricity

CT3: Decarbonising heating and cooling

CT4: Biomass Mobilization and Sustainability

CT5: Decarbonising Transport

CT6: Consumer/citizen engagement

In accordance with Art. 2 para. (2) from Law no. 160/2012, for the approval of GEO no. 33/2007 regarding the amendment and completion of the Electricity Law no. 13/2007 and Gas Law no. 351/2004, ANRE's own revenues also come from funds granted by international bodies. The total budget allocated for ANRE is 49,750 Euros, of which: 24,500 Euros – direct

staff costs, 15,300 Euros – other direct costs (travel to project meetings, organization/participation/travel to workshops, organization of online sessions) and indirect costs of 9,950 Euro. For the implementation of the CA-RES4 Project, ANRE collected on August 6, 2021 the amount of 24,045.83 Euros from the 49,750 Euros budgeted for ANRE (representing a pre-financing of 48.33%).
