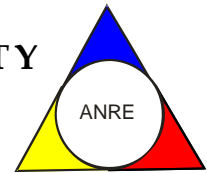

Regarding: All NEMO's proposal for the Market Coupling Operator functions (MCO Plan) provided according to Article 7(3) of the Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/1222 of 24 July 2015 establishing a Guideline on Capacity Allocation and Congestion Management.

According to the provisions of Article 7(3) of the Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/1222 of 24 July 2015 establishing a Guideline on Capacity Allocation and Congestion Management (CACM Regulation), all the designated electricity market operators (NEMO) developed a plan on joint set up and performance of the Market Coupling Operator functions (MCO Plan) that was sent to ANRE by electronic mail at 14 April 2016, registered under ANRE entry number 28942 of 15 April 2016.

According to Article 9(6)(a) of the CACM Regulation, this proposal shall be subject to the approval of all national regulatory authorities, that according to Article 9(3) shall consult and closely cooperate and coordinate with each other in order reach an agreement within 6 months following the submission.

In this context, we wish to inform you that on 13 September, during the Energy Regulators Forum (ERF), it was discussed the request of all national regulatory authorities on amendment of the MCO Plan, and on 26 September 2016 there was held an electronic voting procedure to confirm the agreement of all national regulatory authorities on the contents of this document.

Since it was reached an agreement of all national regulatory authorities, please find attached **The Request all national regulatory authorities for amendment of the MCO Plan proposal**, in Romanian and English, under the provisions of Article 9(12) of CACM Regulation. In accordance with the provisions of the same article, NEMOs shall submit for approval a proposal for amendment of the MCO Plan within two months from the national regulatory authorities request.
